

The Day of Prayer and Meditation

On the holy day of St. Joseph and the fourth anniversary of our Church and center in Toronto, it was our great pleasure and honor to have His Eminence Aloysius Cardinal Ambrozic, Archbishop of Toronto invited by our Archbishop H. Zora to preside at the Stations of the Cross. We shared our joy afterwards with dinner in honor of this great occasion. His Eminence stayed with us for several hours and the congregation was full of happiness and joy at his devotion and paternal good example during the Stations of the Cross. I would like to assure your Eminence personally of my support to confront all the problems and difficulties that are coming against the Holy and Apostolic Church at this time. Together we will resolve these difficulties with prayer, patience, strength and joy.

He also remarked on our closeness to God, to our Church and to our pastors. He wished a good future and prosperity to whole community.
